

Varsity Tournament Information –

Pool Play 9/15/2018

Coaches and Officials, We will play out corners. Home teams are listed first, will wear light and provide game ball. Visiting teams are listed second and will wear dark. No team time-outs. All games will be timed by the central horn to begin game, indicate half-time, and end game. **Ties stand.** All pools A, B, C, and D will be hosted at Serra. Only 8 teams will return for elimination play on 9/22/2018.

The four 1st place teams will be seeded 1-4 based on total points. The four 2nd place teams will be seeded 5-8 based on total points.

Points will be determined as follows:

3pts – for a win, plus 1pt for each goal scored up to 3

1pt - for a tie, plus 1pt for each goal scored up to 3

0pt - for a loss, plus 1 pt for each goal scored up to 3

1pt - extra for a shutout win

If there is a tie in the standings of the pool, we will break it in this order:

- 1.Head to head competition
2. Least goals allowed
- 3.Most goals scored
- 4.Coin toss

Prior to the first game all teams MUST register at the concession area, pick up a packet, which will include information for reporting scores, nomination sheets for all tournament team, tournament rule sheet, etc. **ALL-TOURNAMENT NOMINATION FORMS CAN BE TURNED IN TO ME AT THE TOURNAMENT OR EMAILED WITH ALL THE APPROPRIATE INFORMATION BY TUESDAY 9/18.** Ice and bags for injuries will be at each field, but coaches are responsible for administering first aid to their athletes.

All ties for games #1-9 will be broken with a normal round of 1 V 1. If still tied, then it will go to sudden victory 1V 1. Game #10 (Championship final) will include one 10 minute sudden victory overtime, followed by normal 1V1, then sudden victory 1V1 if still tied.

Teams with the highest seed will wear light, lowest seed wears dark and provides the game ball.
